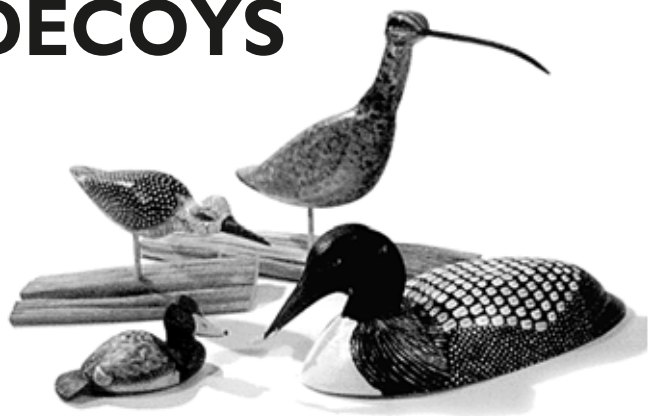

George Porter's family started leather tooling in 1610 in Wymouth, England. He is the 13th generation to carry on the tradition.

His great uncle carved decoys, wagon spokes, canes and other wooden implements from the turn of the century until the late 1930's.

George started carving decoys in 1971 and has broadened his skills to include duck and fish carvings, fishing plugs, iron working and making leather clothes. He uses many traditional tools in his carvings.

He has been featured on PBS's Discover Wisconsin and in regional newspapers like the Appleton Post Crescent and the Vilas County Reporter.

The Porter family lives in rural Wausaukee and are building a log home for themselves.
