MINUTES**

1. Call to Order – Jeff Townsend called the meeting to order at 5:02pm. The following committee members present were Rosalyn Figas, and John Ranallo. Also present were Village Trustees Randy Schmidt, Julie Parkansky and Village Clerk Toshia Ranallo.
2. Approval of Agenda – Rosalyn Figas made a motion seconded by John Ranallo. To approve the agenda. Motion carried.
3. Discussion – Village Constable – President Townsend stated that if we are going to clean up the Village and make it a more desirable place to live, we need someone to enforce our ordinances. Ordinances like grass cutting, storage of junk, farm animals, dog barking, etc. After an extended discussion the committee requested Clerk Ranallo to gather the following information from surrounding municipalities. What qualifications are needed for the position? Who can contact the Constable? How is the Constable protected? What kind of equipment is needed? Does the Constable have a schedule or an on call basis? How do they write citations? Are they a resident of the municipality? What are the wages? Do we need a judge? This matter will be discussed at the Special Village Board Meeting on Monday June 29, 2009 at 6:00 pm.
4. Discussion – Letter to residents about Ordinance enforcement – John Ranallo stated that he will go through the most common ordinances that Village residents tend to violate and summarize an outline and present it at the next regular board meeting. Ranallo stated that he would like to have the final draft sent to all residents. He added that the outline ought to be sent with the water sewer utility bills.
5. Adjourn – Rosalyn Figas made a motion seconded by John Ranallo to adjourn the meeting at 5:48 pm. Motion carried.
