MINUTES

1. Call to Order – Chairman Hilbert Radtke called the meeting to order at 7:03 pm. Committee members in attendance were Kellen Stumbris and Bob Wesolowski. Also in attendance were Village Treasurer Sara Pullen, Village Streets Supervisor Darryll Schmidt and resident Ruth Jicha.
2. Approval of Agenda – Trustee Wesolowski made a motion seconded by Trustee Stumbris to approve the agenda. Motion carried.
3. Discussion – Department Hours – Radtke asked Schmidt if he thought part-time workers should be asked to work on Saturdays to help keep the park cleaner for campers. Schmidt stated that whoever is on call to do Water/Sewer checks on weekends was always supposed to check park bathrooms as well so it may not be necessary. Radtke stated that it's something to think about especially if they do not reach their allotted 20 hours during the week. The Committee will not recommend any change to the Street Department hours at this time.
4. Discussion – Log Keeping & Work Procedures – Radtke asked that the part-time help record a log this summer. He continued by telling Schmidt that his logs look good and to keep up the good work. The Committee will make no recommendation to the Board on log keeping at this time.

Radtke asked Schmidt if there is a way to speed up the time it takes to water trees. Schmidt stated that the Village would need a pump and a tank. Radtke asked what could be done about the property along the tracks on County C. Schmidt stated that DeLaet could bring in the John Deere 750 bulldozer for \$100 per hour and level it. He continued that a disc could be brought in after that. Radtke stated that this would add to the total hours as far as grass cutting goes. He also reminded Schmidt to be sure and pick up any garbage that he sees along the Village Streets and asked that the part-time help understand that's part of their job as well. Radtke told Schmidt to fill the transverse cracks this summer. He mentioned an attachment to the tractor bucket that would make picking up garbage when mowing much easier and wanted Schmidt to look into it. Stumbris asked when Schmidt was planning on straightening out street signs. Schmidt replied that the budget only allowed for Stop and Yield signs this year. No recommendations will be made at this time.

5. Adjourn – Stumbris made a motion seconded by Wesolowski to adjourn at 7:30 pm. Motion carried.
