MINUTES**

1. Call to Order – Chairman John Ranallo called the meeting to order at 5:36pm. Committee members present were Ann Hartnell, Kyle Stumbris and Jeff Townsend. Also present were American Legion Representative Mike Gavigan, Wausaukee Lions Club Representative Jim Jorgenson, Street Supervisor Darryll Schmidt, and Town of Wausaukee Supervisor Bob Ranallo.
2. Approval of Agenda – Hartnell made a motion seconded by Townsend to approve the agenda. Motion carried.
3. Discussion – 4<sup>th</sup> of July Celebration – Ranallo explained previous 4<sup>th</sup> of July Celebrations were divided in many different areas. He stated the goal this year is to have the celebration centered in a specific area such as Ballas Park. Ranallo explained Ballas Park is the property of the Village and Town of Wausaukee and the ambition is to get the community together and develop the area with playground equipment, pavilions, new restroom facilities and etc.

After an extended discussion it was decided tonight's meeting was in the developmental stage and committee members and members of the community would explore the following ideas:

Ranallo stated that he would organize baseball and softball games throughout the day for all ages. He will also look into having inflatable jumpers and other activities for youngsters. Ranallo will contact the Wausaukee Community Association about possibly organizing a 5K run/walk.

Jeff Townsend will approach Wausaukee Fire Department members for volunteers to play in a softball game against other fire departments.

Kyle Stumbris will look into fireworks and layout of activities.

Darryll Schmidt may possibly provide the fishing tank.

Ann Hartnell will contact the county for permission to use their land for parking and to stage the fireworks.

Mike Gavigan will contact a bank in setting up a fund account that would hold donated money for the development of Ballas Park.

A future meeting was scheduled for February 16 at 5:30pm. Any interested participants are encouraged to attend.

4. Adjourn – Ann Hartnell made a motion seconded by Kyle Stumbris to adjourn the meeting at 6:38pm. Motion carried.
