MINUTES**

1. Call to Order – Chairman Hilbert Radtke called the meeting to order at 7:08pm. Committee member Kyle Stumbris was present. Also in attendance were Rosalyn Figas, Ann Hartnell, John Ranallo, Quade Ranallo, Quest Ranallo and Clerk Toshia Ranallo.
2. Approval of Agenda – Stumbris made a motion seconded by Radtke to approve the agenda. Motion carried.
3. Discussion – Open Culvert under CTY C – The committee will recommend to the full board opening up the culvert. Radtke will contact Marinette County and ask if the culvert is their responsibility since it is under their highway.
4. Discussion – Filling in the hole by Well #1 near Caine’s Farm – Figas stated that Caine’s farm is digging a new manure pit and are offering the fill to the Village to fill the hole by well #1. Figas added that the reason the Village hasn’t filled in the hole before is because it was not cost effective. Now there is an opportunity for free fill.

According to the Town of Wausaukee and Village of Wausaukee Wetland Map this area is considered wetlands. The Wellhead Protection Ordinance also states that the manure pit needs to be at least 1000 feet from our well. Radtke will contact Robert Rosenberg from the Department of Natural Resources and ask if the Village can fill the hole.

Figas mentioned that 2 street lights are also needed by Well #1.

5. Discussion – Snow Removal Policy – The committee will recommend to the full board to continue to remove the snow off of Main Street. Property owners are obligated to dispose of the snow piles at their own expense and cannot push snow where it may become a hazard. If property owners are unable to remove snow piles that become hazardous, the Village will have them removed and then invoice the property owner accordingly. A notice will be published in the newspaper and Main Street property owners will be notified by mail.
6. Adjourn – Stumbris made a motion seconded by Radtke to adjourn the meeting at 7:55pm. Motion carried.
